### Abstract

Fires are among the most common incidents, each with unique causes that require specific solutions. The Multi Sensor Fire Detection System (MSFDS) is a crucial area of research. A straightforward Raspberry Pi-based algorithm is used to detect fires and determine the distance to the source, guiding the robot to extinguish the flames. The robot activates automatically upon detection of a fire. When the robot approaches the fire, a centrifugal pump is utilized to pump water for extinguishing, and a water spreader ensures efficient firefighting. The use of the water spreader has been found to significantly reduce water velocity. Both a flame sensor and an IR sensor are employed for fire detection and distance measurement. The navigation algorithm enables the robot to find the most effective path.
