8.2. Academic Audit and Actions Taken thereof during the Period of Assessment (15)

(Academic audit system/process and its implementation in relation to continuous improvement.)

Academic Auditing System Overview

A robust academic auditing system has been implemented to evaluate and ensure the quality, compliance, and effectiveness of academic programs, courses, faculty, and overall learning processes. The primary goal of this academic audit is to improve teaching and learning outcomes. The audit is conducted both internally and externally to enhance the teaching and learning process. The academic audit process is as follows and is presented in pictorial format in




Fig No.8.2.1: The Academic Audit Process.



1. Microteaching

Microteaching sessions are conducted at the beginning of each semester to evaluate faculty preparedness in delivering courses and maintaining course files. The process includes:

Preparation of Course Files Course files should be prepared well in advance before the commencement of classes. These files are then checked by the module coordinator and the Head of Department (HoD).

Random Selection and Presentation Faculty from each department will be randomly selected to present a lecture on a topic chosen by the Academic Dean and the Principal.

Evaluation of Presentation During their presentation, the performance of the faculty members is evaluated based on specific criteria. Those who achieve a good score will be allowed to handle classes. If a faculty member does not score well, they will be given time to improve by referring to various textbooks and seeking guidance from senior staff members. They must then re-present their lecture for re-evaluation. The sample circular for microteaching for the academic year 23-24(odd) and the corresponding scorecard are presented in Figure 8.2.2 and Figure 8.2.3




Fig No.8.2.3: Sample scoresheet for the academic year 2023-24 Odd.

2. Classroom Monitoring




Fig No.8.2.4: Sample class monitoring record by HoD.

3. Internal Course File Audit

The Academic Assessment Cell is functioning properly to monitor the academic process, headed by Dr. A.P. Pusphalatha, Prof. and Head of the Maths department. The academic assessment processes are as follows:

Course File Audit: A course file audit is conducted by the academic audit committee once every three months.

Monitoring Assessment Activities: All assessment activities are monitored by the academic audit committee members as per the SOP regarding course files and logbooks. The sample auditing circular for the academic year 2023-24 Odd is shown in Figure 8.2.5

Submitting Audit Reports: Audit reports are submitted by the committee members to the coordinator within the due date. The sample audit report for the academic year 2023-24 Odd is shown in Figure 8.2.6

Consolidation and Approval: All reports from the auditors of each department are consolidated by the coordinator and approved by the Principal.



Circulation and Corrections: Copies of the consolidated report are circulated to all departments. Corrections are carried out by each department, and these corrections are verified again by the auditor, who then provides the correction report to the coordinator.




Fig No.8.2.5: The sample auditing circular for the academic year 2023-24 Odd.

4.Class Committee Meeting

The Class Committee meeting is conducted periodically to obtain feedback from students to know about teaching learning process. The process of the class committee meeting is as follows and its conducted three times in each semester.



Nomination of chairperson: The chairperson has been nominated for each class. The nominated person should not handle the class for the particular section, and mostly senior staff members have been allocated. This process is conducted by Academic Dean and the Principal.

Nomination of students and Feedback Collection: In each class, four Class Committee members are nominated, and their names are shared with the respective chairpersons. Meetings are conducted on the scheduled dates, during which feedback is collected from the committee members about the teaching and learning process. This feedback is reported to the Principal. A copy is submitted to the concerned HoD for further action. If any inconvenience is identified for students, necessary actions should be taken by the respective HoD. 


Fig No.8.2.11: Sample External audit follow-up report for the academic year 2023-24 Odd.




Fig No.8.3: Number of publications in conferences.


